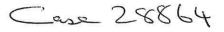

WHEREAS, the said resolution ratified and confirmed the Commissioner of Sanitation's action, in retaining Anker's Electric Service, Inc. under an emergency agreement to eliminate the threat to public safety by restoring electric power to the Department of Sanitation's facilities and allowing the department to restore operational capabilities; and

WHEREAS, in the course of Anker's Electric Service Inc.'s performing work under the emergency agreement, it was determined that (a) the scope of work agreed to between the town and Anker's was insufficient to restore electrical power as required and (b) that significant damage had been done to data utilities at the Department of Sanitation offices, exacerbating the emergency by making telephone, Internet and e-mail service unavailable to the department further disrupting its ability to provide storm clean-up and normal services; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Commissioner of Sanitation, continuance of the emergency, caused by the disruption, posed a continued threat to public health and safety and otherwise constituted a public emergency under General Municipal Law § 103(4); and

WHEREAS, Anker's Electric Service, Inc. made a further proposal to restore wiring and associated equipment sufficient to fully restore electric, telephone, Internet and e-mail service to the Department of Sanitation's offices which proposal was reviewed and found acceptable and reasonable by the Commissioner of Sanitation and the department's consultant, H2M PC Architects and Engineers, and was determined to be fair, reasonable and in accordance with industry standards; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to restore operational capabilities and abate the emergency, the Commissioner of Sanitation accepted the above-referenced further proposal and ordered Anker's Electric Service to provide service pursuant to it; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board concurs with the actions taken by the Commissioner of Sanitation as aforesaid;
