No agency, department or unit of federal, state or local government shall enter upon private property to conduct any excavation thereon for purposes including but not limited to environmental testing or remediation, except upon not less than two weeks written notice, mailed to the owner of the subject private property by certified mail, return receipt requested, at the subject premises, and to the owner's last known address, if it is different location from the subject private premises.
- B. The said notice shall state the reason for the excavation, the scope of the work, the date that work shall be commenced, the hours during which work shall be performed, and the approximate date of completion.
- C. This section shall be construed as to supplement and not supplant any and all applicable regulations of the agency performing the excavation, and nothing herein shall relieve such agency from the obligation to follow any and all such regulations that are otherwise applicable in regard to performing excavations on private property, including but not limited to any requirement to obtain the consent of the owner and/or any other party or entity prior to commencing work.

A local law to repeal and reenact section one hundred eighteen dash eleven (A) and section one hundred eighteen dash sixteen of chapter one hundred eighteen the code of the town of Hempstead in relation to prohibitory signage and penalties for violation of peddling and soliciting regulations in the Town of Hempstead

## Introduced by:

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Hempstead as follows:

Section One. Section one hundred and eighteen dash eleven (A) of chapter 118 the code of the town of Hempstead, is hereby repealed and reenacted such that it shall read as follows:

## § 118-11. Prohibitions.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon private premises for the purpose of peddling or soliciting where there is posted, painted or otherwise affixed or displayed in plain view, a "no peddlers" or "no solicitors" or "Do Not Knock" sign.

Section Two. Section one hundred eighteen dash sixteen of chapter 118 of the code of the Town of Hempstead, is hereby repealed and reenacted such that it shall read as follows:

#### \$118-16. Penalties for offenses.

Any person, as defined in this chapter, committing an offense against this chapter or any section or provision thereof shall be guilty of a violation punishable by a fine of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each such offense. Each separate day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
