This amendment, which is dated as of November _____, 2016 (the "Fifth Amendment"), amends and, as contemplated in a Town request for proposals ("RFP"), renews the Agreement dated June 4, 2008 (as amended on January 1, 2009 "the First Amendment", as amended on November 12, 2010 "the Second Amendment", as amended on October 14, 2011 "the Third Amendment" and as amended on April 9, 2015 "the Fourth Amendment") entered into between **Westbury Paper Stock Corp.**, a New York Corporation with offices located at 173 School Street, Westbury, New York 11590 ("Westbury Paper") and the **Town of Hempstead**, a municipal corporation of the State of New York, with offices located at One Washington Street, Hempstead, New York 11550 and the Town Board of the Town of Hempstead on behalf of the Town of Hempstead Refuse Disposal District (collectively, the "Town"), as follows:

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the RFP duly issued by the Town, Westbury Paper and the Town entered into a contract for the provision of facilities and/or equipment to accept or pick up residential recyclable material collected pursuant to the Town's curbside recycling program; and

WHEREAS, the initial term of the Agreement expired on October 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement included an option for two renewals periods, with each renewal to last for a period of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, the first renewal period expired on October 31, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the parties have expressed their mutual consent to the lawful renewal of the Agreement and to, among other things, confirm the existence, validity and enforceability of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Fifth Amendment is consistent with the request for proposals issued by the Town through which Westbury Paper was selected as the vendor to accept newspaper and other recyclable materials;

NOW, *THEREFORE*, in consideration of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged and conceded, and the covenants and agreements set forth herein, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- The Contract shall be renewed for a five (5) year period to commence on November 1, 2016 and end on October 31, 2021 (the "Second Renewal Term").
- Effective November 1, 2016, Paragraph 3 of the Agreement is hereby amended to replace subparagraphs (a) and (b) and Paragraph 4 in their entirety with the following:
 - a. For each ton of Newspaper delivered to the Westbury Paper facility, Westbury Paper shall pay to the Town \$16.00.
 - b. For each ton of Commingled Materials delivered to the Westbury
 Paper facility, the Town shall pay to Westbury Paper \$10.00.

- 3. Effective November 1, 2016, the Town shall use reasonable efforts to reduce non-recyclable residue in the commingled bottles and cans, as well as from the newspaper, and work together with Westbury Paper to effectuate same. If during the term of this extension of the Agreement the Town cannot reduce the residue, then the Town and Westbury Paper shall discuss a resolution in good faith, for the disposition of the residue in the recyclable material.
- 4. In the event the Town and Westbury Paper shall be unable to reach a resolution in good faith, as discussed above, then either party shall be free to terminate this agreement on nine (9) months' written notice to the other party.
- Except as modified or amended herein, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the remainder of the Second Renewal Term.
